- Thursday, April 4, 7:00 PM, Mauldin High School Aud. Call time: 5:30 PM, 5:00 for setup crew (joint concert with high school All-County performers)
- Saturday, May 25, Mauldin Cultural Center. Band festival; performances from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM, our performance time a little after 6:00 PM. Food will be provided.

 - March 28: rehearsal is at Mauldin High School, joint with HS musicians
 - April 18: normal rehearsal, despite Greenville schools Spring Break

- In the past our policy was to cancel rehearsals if the Greenville schools were out.
